### **Installation Instruction**

- \* Ensure the unit has input, output voltage and output wattage proper for your application.

## Mounting

The transformer must be mounted in at least 15" of free flow air space for proper ventilation.

The transformer must never be mounted next to or above heat radiated objects.

The maximum ambient temperature should not exceed 50 deg. C (110 deg. F).

Attach mounting plate to the rigid vertical surface with a two screws. Hang transformer on the hook of the mounting plate vertically when installed outdoor.

When mounting indoor the unit can be installed horizontally, as well

#### Connection

Open the input wire compartment and remove knockouts for input and output, install strain reliefs (wire clamps). Use only right size and UL approved wire nuts.

## Input Connection


Bring your line and neutral wires through input strain relief and connect them to the Black and White transformers leads.

# **Output Connection**

Bring your lights wires through output strain relief and connect 1st circuit to the #1 terminal block positions, positive to "+" and negative to "-", the remaining circuits connect to #2 terminal block positions in the same polarity way. Max. wattage per circuit is 100W Make sure all your connection very tight.

## Grounding

The core and coil assemblies are grounded to the enclosure. The enclosure in turn should be grounded in accordance with NEC and local code. Connect the transformer green wire to the ground.
